*The goal of the training is to advance the skills of laborers and to make area advanced manufacturers more competitive in the global marketplace.*

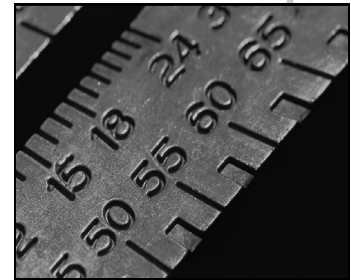
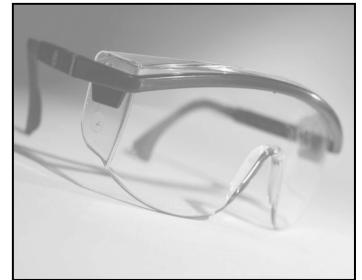
*This grant will assist members of the Wisconsin Precision Metalworking Council (WPMC) in providing training to their incumbent workers.*
