

# Advancing Manufacturing into the Global Marketplace (AMGM)

Training Grant for Incumbent Workers

## **NEW EMPLOYER FACT SHEET**

### **Q. Which companies are eligible to apply for AMGM grant reimbursement funding?**

**A.** Any company (small to mid-size) in the Milwaukee 7 Region that is a member of the Wisconsin Precision Metalworking Council (WPMC) is eligible to apply. \* To become a member of the Wisconsin Precision Metalworking Council contact Becky Fischer @262-532-2440 or rfisher@teamwi.com

### **Q. What kind of training qualifies for reimbursement under this grant?**

**A.** Generally, training on computer software and production-line machines. Instruction must take place at a school, training facility, or worksite of a WPMC member. (A detailed list of allowable trainings will be shared upon request.)

### **Q. For which of my employees can I request training funds?**

**A.** In order for an employee to be eligible for AMGM training funds they must be:

- An incumbent worker (working at the organization for at least 90 days)
- 18 years of age or older
- A US Citizen or Legally eligible to work in the United States
- Registered with Selective Services (there are some exceptions)

### **Q. How much money is available?**

**A. NEW!** Each eligible company is now allowed up to **\$36,000** in grant reimbursement funds with a **\$6,000** per person limit. **NEW!** **The funding for this grant ends December 2010.**

### **Q. Will the employer be reimbursed 100% for the cost of the training?**

**A. NEW!** The first \$3,000 of training per person is reimbursed to participating companies at 100%. Employer match of 25% for any amount over \$3,000 is required with the maximum reimbursement per trainee being \$6,000 and the maximum total reimbursement per company being \$36,000.
