Opportunity Grants

Grants up to \$1000

Up to \$250 in Wrap-Around Services**

Purpose:

To help individuals not otherwise eligible for financial aid improve their skills at technical colleges, earn certificates or degrees, and pursue career pathways to better jobs in high-demand occupations.

Grant funding to be used to cover the cost of tuition* for short-term or less than half-time training at a technical college.

Qualifications:

Must be at least 18 years old & a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen with a valid Social Security Number.

Must possess a High School diploma or equivalent (from a school in the United States).

Do not already have a degree beyond high school and are not full-time college students.

Must be employed, on temporary layoff status, or actively registered with an Employment Agency.

Family income earnings must be *at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines*.

*Tuition: *Tuition costs include instructional costs, fees paid directly to the school, books & consumable supplies/materials.*

**Wrap-around Services: *Wrap-around services include the cost of uniforms, tools, licensure exam fees, transportation assistance, childcare and other supports necessary for the successful participation in training.*
